**Corrigendum No – 1**

Based on the pre-bid meeting held on 30/01/2025, the following updates have been made in the tender document

S.No	Section & clause	Updated clause
1.	Section 2 [2.2 (1)]	The interim & final reports for the post-monsoon & pre-monsoon surveys shall be submitted, which shall include high-quality images, maps, comprehensive analysis data & other related data as provided in Section 2.2.  Two reports (Interim & Final) for all sites should be printed on an A3-sized paper (or better), with a paper quality of 160 GSM (or better), and must have a hardcover for both front and back. For each site location, 5-7 physical copies of the interim & final reports shall be submitted.
2	Section 2 [2.1]	The location and boundary details of the site locations can be accessed at the link - <a href="https://rsis.ramsar.org/">https://rsis.ramsar.org/</a>
3	Section 2 [2.2 (4)]	Any of the Industry-standard technologies such as multi-beam surveying, bottom profilers, acoustic Doppler current profilers, echo sounders, manual methods, or other suitable techniques can be used to conduct an accurate and reliable bathymetric survey.

4.	Section 3	<p>A valid payload-owning certificate or lease agreement for the payload shall be submitted for each payload to be used in the survey. Details of the owned/leased payload along with specifications shall be uploaded.</p> <p>The validity of the lease agreement for the payload by the bidder should be before the tender start date and should be beyond the 12 months from the tender closing date</p>
5.	Section 3 3.1, 3.2, 3.3	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Ground-to-sample distance (GSD) can be 5-10 cm or better.</li> <li>● Data accuracy shall be 5-10 cm (or better) for sections 3.1 &amp; 3.2 and +/- 2 to 4 cm (or better) for section 3.3.</li> </ul>
6.	Section 4 (ii)	Additionally, preference will be given to the bidder, who has an agreement / MoU with OEM.
7.	Section 4 (v)	The Bidder can have a registered office anywhere in India. However, preference will be given to the bidder, who has at least one operational office/support centre in Tamil Nadu. Documentary proof for the same is needed.
8.	Section 4 (vii)	As an additional criterion, DGCA-approved type-certified drones with UIN shall only be used.
9.	Section 7 [7.1]	<p>The payment shall be released in four instalments as follows:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. 25% upon completion of the first survey/post-monsoon survey.</li> <li>b. 25% upon submission of the interim report and the processed data.</li> <li>c. 30% upon completion of the second survey/pre-monsoon survey and submission of the comprehensive report.</li> <li>d. The remaining 20% will be released upon final approval from the technical committee and submission of all required deliverables</li> </ol>
10.	Section 7 [7.6]	After the final submission of the comprehensive report and all necessary deliverables, the security deposit will be returned to the bidder.

- For technical bid evaluation, scoring will be applied to Section 4 - (ii), (iv), (v), and the Payload specification (refer to point 3 above). The bidder must meet all other criteria outlined in Section 4 to qualify for the technical bid.

- No further modifications or amendments will be made to this tender document. Any other queries raised by the bidder that have not been addressed in this corrigendum shall be deemed unaccepted.
